SUPPLEMENTARY NOTES

I. Smith – N. Tache

- [1] Over 2 ♦ “Multi” responder has the following bids:
2 ♥ = weak or INV in ♠
2 ♠ = P or INV in ♥
2 NT = asks partner to describe his opening:
 3 ♣ / ♦ = good and max. in ♥ / ♠
3 ♣ / ♦ = F1R
3 ♥ = P or C
4 ♣ = asks opener to show his suit in transfer
4 ♥ = PRE, P or C
If opener bids nNT showing 22-23 balanced: system on
- [2] **3 Way:** 1 m – 2 ♥: Responder shows either of 3 types of hand:
1. Support in m FG
2. Balanced hand, 13+ HCP
3. Strong ♥ suit, 13+ HCP
Opener may inquire with the relay of 2♠, bid 2 NT with minimum or bid naturally with a strong opening.
1m - 2♥ - 2♠:
2 NT = 13 + balanced
3 ♣ = SUPP in m, with S
3 ♦ = SUPP in m without S
3 ♥ = Quasi solid ♥ suit, 13+ HCP; Relays by opener ask for further information.
- [3] **Bergen raises:** Over 1 M opening:
2 M = 3 card SUPP, 8 – 10 HCP
3 ♣ = 4 card SUPP, 8 – 10 HCP
3 ♦ = 4 card SUPP, 11 – 12 HCP
3 M = PRE, 4 card SUPP, < 8 HCP
3 OM = 4 card SUPP, 9 – 12 HCP, unspecified S; opener asks with 3 NT
4 ♣ = 5 card SUPP, 1 outside ace
4 ♦ = 5 card SUPP, better hand than 1 outside ace
4 M = 5 card SUPP, NO quick trick
- [4] **Jacoby:** Over 1 M opening:
2 NT = 4+ card SUPP, 13+ HCP.
Opener: Shows S or V; bids 3 M with good hand or jumps to 4 M with minimum opening;
 4 of another suit is 5+ cards and at least 2H
- [5] Over 1 m – 1 M – 1 NT we play:
2 ♣: asks for SUPP + strength:
 2 ♦ = min., NO support
 2 M = min, SUPP
 2 OM = Max., SUPP
 2 NT = Max., NO SUPP
- [6] **Puppet Stayman:** Over 2 NT (20 – 21 HCP) 3 ♣ asks:
3 ♦ = NO 4+ ♥ NOR 5 ♠
3 ♥ = 4+ ♥ (4 ♠ asks: 4 or 5 ?)
3 ♠ = 5 ♠
3 NT = both M (4,4) ; responder transfers
If responder over 3 ♦ bids 3 ♥, he asks for the number of ♠
